

Summary of Proposed Bylaws Revisions

March 2019

The AASM Board of Directors periodically reviews governance documents as part of its general oversight of the organization. During a recent review of the bylaws, the AASM Board of Directors identified and recommended changes. These changes were reviewed by legal counsel and are now being presented for adoption by the membership.

ARTICLE II – MEMBERS

Section 2 - Qualifications for Membership

- iii. Sleep Medicine Trainee Members: Updated to specify United States based physicians
 participating in an ACGME-accredited sleep medicine fellowship training program, or similar
 training program.
- **iv. In-Training Members:** Updated to include all members in a formal training program that are not in the Sleep Medicine Trainee member category.
