Azizi Seixas, Ph.D. is the Interim Inaugural Chair of the Department of Informatics and Health Data Science, Founding Director of The Media and Innovation Lab (The MIL), Associate Director of the Center for Translational Sleep and Circadian Sciences (TSCS), and Director of Population Health Informatics within the Institute for Data Science and Computing at the University of Miami Miller School of Medicine. Dr. Seixas is a nationally recognized scientist and technology leader. He was named Cell Press' Top 100 Most Inspiring Black Scientists in America, 2022 Amazon's Education Champion Award, 2023 M.I.A. Miami's Most Influential and Powerful Black Business Leader, 2024 M.I.A. South Florida's Black Educator of the Year, 2024 Academy of Science, Engineer and Medicine of Florida Rising Star Award, the winner of the Inaugural 2024 Tipping Point Award from Malcolm Gladwell and T-Mobile, 2025 South Florida Hispanic Chamber of Commerce's Health Tech Vanguard Award, and 2025 US Presidential Early Career Award for Scientists and Engineers (PECASE) the highest honor given to scientist at this stage of their career by the US government.
